The BREEDER does not assume any liability for any injury to said puppy after delivery to the arranged dog shipper.

The BUYER is strongly advised to have the puppy vet checked within three days of delivery. If the vet certifies that there is any problem which makes the PUPPY unfit for sale, provided the PUPPY is returned in the same condition as when it was sold, and within 14 days the BREEDER will take the PUPPY back and refund the full purchase price. The BREEDER will not pay expenses incurred in the return of a PUPPY nor accept any claim for distress caused by the return, nor pay any veterinary bills. .

The BUYER should provide yearly examinations, vaccinations, heartworm tests, and any other usual procedures necessary to assure good health. If so, and if the PUPPY is documented by a veterinarian to have a severe congenital defect, which will significantly alter its quality of life, within 3 years of birth, BREEDER will replace the puppy with one of equal or greater value when one becomes available or the purchase price or the BREEDER'S discretion. The finding will need to be sent to my personal Veterinarian for corroboration and breeding information purposes.

Should the BUYER need to rehome your puppy or adult dog for any reason, "Please" feel we are a safe place to provide support and assistance. Our main concern is for the health and happiness of both your family and the puppy. I will help in rehoming any Outback bred dog for any reason.

There are many factors that can influence growth and development, such as diet, exercise, weight gain, etc. The BUYER assumes the responsibility to carry on with the appropriate vaccinations, exercise and feeding. The BREEDER can offer no further guarantees once the care of the puppy is no longer under their control.

Seller/ Breeder: The seller assumes no responsibility for this puppy after leaving the premises: Loss of the animal, medical expenses, landlord's disapproval, allergy, disagreement to family, barking, digging, or for any other reason stated. We also do not cover unforeseen treatable issues, including teeth removal, base narrow, allergies, UTI's, or parasites, umbilical hernias, and other easily treatable maladies.

The breeder is not responsible for any veterinarian bill of any kind or any other bill regarding this puppy nor is the breeder responsible for damages, physical, or emotional to the buyer's self or possessions likewise or to other individuals.
